Abstract: Here we describe the isolation of stem cells of the human colonic epithelium. Differential cell surface abundance of ephrin type-B receptor 2 (EPHB2) allows the purification of different cell types from human colon mucosa biopsies. The highest EPHB2 surface levels correspond to epithelial colonic cells with the longest telomeres and elevated expression of intestinal stem cell (ISC) marker genes. Moreover, using culturing conditions that recreate the ISC niche, a substantial proportion of EPHB2-high cells can be expanded in vitro as an undifferentiated and multipotent population.

A bibliometric analysis of tuberculosis research indexed in PubMed, 1997–2006

SUMMARY

OBJECTIVE: To describe a bibliometric review of the literature on tuberculosis (TB) research indexed in PubMed over a 10-year period.

METHODS: Medline was used via the PubMed online service of the US National Library of Medicine from 1997 to 2006. The search strategy was: [(tuberculosis) OR (tuberculous)] in all fields.

RESULTS: A total of 35 735 references were located. The average annual growth rate was +4.7%. The articles were published in 2874 scientific journals. Sixteen journals contained 25% of the TB journal literature. The main journal was the *International Journal of Tuberculosis and Lung Disease*. Western Europe was the most productive region, with 31.1% of the articles. The USA

ranked second (21%) and Asia third (19.9%). The USA is the predominant country, followed by India, Japan and the United Kingdom. When normalised by population, the order of prominence is Switzerland, New Zealand and Denmark. Normalised by GDP, Gambia, Malawi and Guinea-Bissau were the most productive countries. Normalised by estimated number of TB cases, Iceland, Switzerland and Norway were in leading positions.

CONCLUSIONS: There was increasing research activity in the field of TB during the period 1997–2006. The countries with more estimated cases of TB produced less research in TB than industrialised countries.

RESEARCH IS IMPORTANT for a country's development and progress. Biomedical research projects usually lead to publications in scientific journals. Original articles allow researchers to present their scientific observations, and the publication of the results of study projects helps share information with the scientific community. Publications are often used as a measure of success in research. In recent years, there has been growing interest in developing scientific indicators capable of facilitating the analysis of the results of research activities.^{1,2}

Tuberculosis (TB) is a major infectious cause of death among adults worldwide. According to the World Health Organization (WHO), there were an estimated 8.8 million new TB cases in 2005.³ Most TB cases occur more commonly in areas with poor socio-economic and health contexts. All countries around the world are devoting effort and resources to fight TB; however, their contribution in terms of research is not well known. International bibliometric studies have been published in other fields of medicine such as anaesthesia and critical care,⁴ dermatology,⁵ gastroenterology,⁶ infectious diseases,⁷ microbiology,⁸ otolaryngology,⁹ oncology,¹⁰ public health,¹¹ respiratory medicine¹² and surgery.¹³ To the best of our knowledge, at least two

studies describing TB research production have been presented at international conferences,^{14,15} however, no such study has yet been published in a journal included in the PubMed database.

The aim of the present investigation was to provide an overview of TB research over a period of 10 years, 1997–2006, using PubMed.

METHODS

The PubMed database was selected as the most suitable for references to TB publications, as it is easily accessible and widely used.¹² PubMed was accessed online* on 2 January 2008 using Reference Manager Programme, version 11 (Thomson Reuters, Carlsbad, CA, USA) as the online tool for searching the bibliographic database and retrieving literature references. The search strategy was: [(tuberculosis) OR (tuberculous) in all fields] AND [(1997)OR(1998)OR(1999)OR(2000)OR(2001)OR(2002)OR(2003)OR(2004)OR(2005)OR(2006) in publication date]. The period of study was from 1997 to 2006, to match world

Views on scientific workflows

Abstract

Workflows are becoming more and more important in e-Science due to the support they provide to scientists in computer simulations, experiments and calculations. Our experiences with workflows in this field and the literature show that scientific workflows consist of a large number of related information. This information is difficult to deal with in a single perspective and has changing importance to scientists in the different workflow lifecycle phases. In this paper we apply viewing techniques known from business process management to (service-based) scientific workflows to address these issues. We describe seven of the most relevant views and point out realization challenges. We argue that the selected views facilitate the handling of workflows to scientists and add further value to scientific workflow systems. An implementation of a subset of the views based on Web services and BP-EL shows the feasibility of the approach. The presented work has the goal to increase additionally the acceptance of the workflow technology in e-Science. © 2011 Springer-Verlag.

Resumen.

Las técnicas cibernéticas se han extendido considerablemente en los últimos años, pero aún faltan estudios en detalle sobre los problemas que plantean dichas técnicas y las posibles soluciones a los mismos. Esta revisión metodológica se centra en la aplicación de la Cibernetría a la obtención de indicadores Web, especialmente aquellos que son útiles para la elaboración de Rankings de carácter institucional. Se estudian las unidades de análisis, las posibilidades y limitaciones de los motores de búsqueda como fuente de información y se describen los métodos de elaboración de Rankings.

Introducción

La cibernetría se ha consolidado en los últimos años como una de las técnicas cuantitativas más interesantes para la descripción y evaluación de la actividad científica (Aguillo et al., 2006), incluyendo la posibilidad todavía no suficientemente explorada de analizar relaciones más amplias del sistema ciencia, economía y sociedad.

Los indicadores Web se han demostrado útiles en contextos de comunicación científica pero el análisis de enlaces requiere todavía de más estudios teóricos antes de entender las y clasificar las motivaciones que llevan al establecimiento de un enlace (Thelwall, 2004). Estas son obviamente más ricas y variadas que la mera cita bibliográfica y por tanto ofrecen una posibilidad inédita en el estudio de las relaciones entre sedes web cualquiera que sea su contenido.

En el presente trabajo se analizan las principales tareas, modelos, técnicas y algunos resultados empíricos de la elaboración de rankings, fundamentalmente universitarios (Aguillo, Ortega y Fernández, 2008), a partir de indicadores Web.

In Vitro Investigation of the Hepatic Extraction of RSD1070, A Novel Antiarrhythmic Compound

Abstract. Purpose. The hepatic extraction of a novel antiarrhythmic, RSD1070, was investigated to test the hypothesis that the poor bioavailability observed in rats is due to high hepatic metabolism. **Methods.** The pharmacokinetics of RSD1070 was examined in rats ($n=8$) and its metabolism was investigated using pooled rat hepatic microsomes. The free fraction in plasma and microsomal matrices was determined by equilibrium dialysis. Hepatic extraction was predicted by scaling-up of the microsomal kinetic data using the well-stirred liver model. **Results.** RSD1070 demonstrated tri-exponential decay following single iv bolus administration of a dose of 12 mg/kg. RSD1070 exhibited a rapid elimination, $t_{1/2}$ of 25 ± 8 min and a CL_{int} of 71 ± 9 mL/min/kg. Renal clearance based on 24 h urinary recovery was determined to be insignificant ($<< 1\%$ of CL_{int}). A Michaelis-Menten model described the elimination of RSD1070 with a K_m of $0.45 \mu\text{g/mL}$ and V_{max} of $2.81 \mu\text{g/min/mg}$ microsomal protein. Taking the V_{max}/K_m ratio (CL_{int}) as the basis for scaling, the data from the microsomal kinetic studies (75 mL/min/kg) closely approximated the apparent CL_{int} . In the scale-up of the *in vitro* CL_{int} , plasma free fraction (1.5%) and microsomal free fraction (15%) were determined and incorporated into the well-stirred liver model. **Conclusion.** RSD1070 is a high hepatic extraction compound ($E = 0.94$) with a predicted CL_{int} value that accounted for the CL_{int} observed in rats.

INTRODUCTION

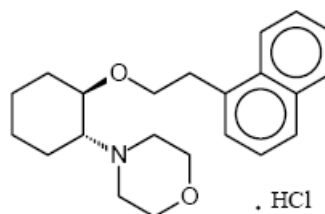


Figure 1: Chemical structure of RSD1070.

RSD1070 [(±)-trans-2-morpholino-1-(1-naphthalene-ethoxy) cyclohexane mono-hydrochloride, Nortran Pharmaceuticals Ltd, Vancouver, BC, Canada] (figure 1) is an experimental antiarrhythmic agent currently in pre-clinical stages of development.

RSD1070 is an analogue of a family of compounds developed to address the need for a drug with high potency and selectivity for pathophysiologically disturbed myocardial tissue (i.e. ischemia). Current antiarrhythmic drug therapy is often unsatisfactory and has been associated with a high risk of provoking arrhythmias (1). One fundamental reason for this side effect is the poor antiarrhythmic efficacy against ischemia/infarction arrhythmias in the clinical setting (2). For example, sodium ion channel blocking agents such as encainide and flecainide lack this selectivity and are liable to be proarrhythmic at therapeutic doses and have resulted in a higher patient mortality in the randomized Cardiac Arrhythmia Suppression Trial (3).
